### PROCEDURAL DEVELOPMENTS

## I. OVERVIEW OF COURT PROCEEDINGS

## MILOŠEVIĆ Case ("Kosovo, Croatia and Bosnia and Herzegovina")

Trial Chamber III - Judges Robinson (Presiding), Kwon and Bonomy

Third week of the Defence case.

On 14 September 2004, the following witness was examined by the Court assigned Defence counsel (see *Press Release* No. 890) and subsequently cross-examined by the Prosecution:

Witness Roland Keith

The Judges gave the Accused the opportunity to put questions to the witness, which he refused.

On 15 September 2004, the parties presented their arguments on the modalities of the assigned Defence Counsel's work. The Trial Chamber denied the Defence request for a further medical examination of the Accused and the Defence request to have the Accused examine the witnesses before the Court assigned Defence counsel. The Trial was then adjourned until 12 October 2004 to allow the Defence Counsel to conduct the investigation and prepare the Defence case.

## MILUTINOVIĆ et al. Case ("Kosovo")

Pre-Trial Judge Bonomy

On 15 September 2004, the parties appeared before the Pre-Trial Judge for a Status Conference pursuant to Rule 65 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence. The next Status Conference was scheduled for 18 January 2005.
