The 6 Accused were not required to be present. Jadranko Prlić, Bruno Stojić, Slobodan Praljak, Milivoj Petković, Valentin Ćorić and Berislav Pušić were provisionally released on 30 July 2004.

The Accused exercised his right under Rule 62 (iii) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence not to enter a plea at this stage. A further appearance will be scheduled within 30 days.
