LIMAJ & BALA & MUSLIU Case

Trial Chamber II – Judges Parker (Presiding), Thelin and Van Den Wyngaert

On 30 November 2005, Trial Chamber II rendered the judgement in the case of the Prosecutor v.Limaj & Bala & Musliu. Fatmir Limaj and Isak Musliu were found not guilty on all charges and both were to be released from the Detention unit. Haradin Bala was convicted and sentenced to 13 years' imprisonment – See Press Release number 1028 dated 30 November 2005.

Fatmir Limaj and Isak Musliu were released on 1 December 2005 – See Press Release number 1029 dated 1 December 2005.

DECISION ON DEFENCE APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATION TO APPEAL THE DECISION ON SCHEDULING OF 18 NOVEMBER 2005

On 2 December 2005, Trial Chamber I denied the "Defence application for certification pursuant to Rule 73(B) of the Rules to appeal against decision on scheduling made 18 November 2005" filed on 25 November 2005. The decision from 18 November 2005 had granted the Defence a seven-week extension up till 28 April 2006 to prepare and present its case and stated that no further extension would be granted unless exceptional circumstances were demonstrated.
