PROCEDURAL DEVELOPMENTS

I. OVERVIEW OF COURT PROCEEDINGS

MILOŠEVIĆ Case

Trial Chamber III - Judges Robinson (Presiding), Kwon and Bonomy

Continuation of the Defence case

From 27 February until 1 March 2006, the following witness was examined by the accused, subsequently cross-examined by the Prosecution and then re-examined by the accused:

• Witness Slobodan Jarčević (minister of foreign affairs of Republika Srpska Krajina during the relevant period)

On 1 March 2006, the following witness was examined by the accused, subsequently cross-examined by the Prosecution and then re-examined by the accused:

• Witness Alice Mahon (politician and member of the British Parliament during the relevant period)

At the end of the session on 1 March 2006, the Trial Chamber granted the request by the assigned defence council to adjourn the trial until 14 March 2006.

MARTIĆ Case

Trial Chamber I – Judges Moloto(Presiding), Nosworthy and Höpfel

Continuation of the Prosecution case

From 2 March to 3 March 2006, the following witness was cross-examined by the Defence:

• Witness Milan Babić (one of the political leaders in Republika Srpska Krajina during the relevant period; accused by the ICTY, he pleaded guilty on 27 January 2004 and the sentencing judgement was rendered on 29 June 2004 – sentence of 13 years – *See Press Release dated 29 June 2004*)

MRKŠIĆ et al. Case

Trial Chamber II - Judges Parker (Presiding), Thelin and Van Den Wyngaert

Continuation of the Prosecution case

From 27 February until 28 February 2006, the trial was conducted in closed sessions.

From 1 March until 3 March 2006, the following witness was examined by the Prosecution, subsequently cross-examined by the Defence and then re-examined by the Prosecution:

• Witness Dragutin Berghofer (eye-witness from Vukovar)

Trial Chamber II – Judges Agius (Presiding), Eser and Brydensholt

Oral evidence of the handwriting expert

From 28 February until 1 March 2006, the parties met to hear the oral evidence of the handwriting expert (Dorijan Keržan from Slovenia), who had been appointed by the Trial Chamber to examine a number of questioned documents. D. Keržan was first examined by the Chamber and subsequently cross-examined by the Defence. After the testimony of the expert, the parties discussed evidentiary matters.

On 1 March 2006, the parties appeared before Judge Meron for a Status Conference pursuant to Rule 65bis of the Rules. The appelant was present.

GALIĆ Case Pre-Appeal Judge Meron

On 2 March 2006, the parties appeared before Judge Meron for a Status Conference pursuant to Rule 65bis of the Rules. The appelant was present.

DELIĆ Case

Pre-Trial Judge Kwon

On 2 March 2006, the parties appeared before Judge Kwon for a Status Conference pursuant to Rule 65bis of the Rules. The accused was not present (provisional release).

DECISION ON DEFENCE'S RULE 74 bis MOTION; AMENDED TRIAL SCHEDULE

On 27 February 2006, Trial Chamber I ordered, *inter alia*, that the Defence shall call its witnesses as of Monday 6 March 2006 and ending no later than Tuesday 4 April 2006. The order further stated that "should the Defence still wish to call the accused as a witness in this case, it is hereby granted an adjournment from Wednesday 5 April to Monday 10 April (inclusive) for further preparation; the accused's examination-in-chief would then start on Tuesday 11 April and last for up to 20 days, that is, until Friday 12 May; cross examination and judges' additional questions would take place between Monday 15 May and Friday 2 June".
