# FINALIZED PROCEDURE ON CHAMBER WITNESSES; DECISIONS AND ORDERS ON SEVERAL EVIDENTIARY AND PROCEDURAL MATTERS

On 24 April 2006, Trial Chamber I issued a number of decisions, some of which are:

- A maximum of seven weeks has been allocated for Mr Krajišnik's testimony, which means that it must come to a close on or before 13 June 2006;
- The Chamber will deliver its judgement in the case on or before 29 September 2006;
- Like any witness who has made a solemn declaration pursuant to Rule 90(B) of the Rules, Mr Krajišnik may not speak to anyone with respect to his testimony.

# DECISION ADOPTING GUIDELINES ON CONDUCT OF TRIAL PROCEEDINGS

On 26 April 2006, pursuant to Article 20(1) of the Statute and Rules 54, 73ter, 89, 90 and 92bis of the Rules, Trial Chamber II adopted guidelines to govern the presentation of evidence and conduct of the proceedings and ordered all parties to comply with them throughout the duration of the case, subject to any further orders by the Trial Chamber. The guidelines stated, inter alia, that the Prosecution shall have a maximum total of 400 hours for the presentation of its evidence, including both examination-in-chief and re-examination.

# DECISION ON STANIŠIĆ DFENCE'S MOTION ON THE FITNESS OF THE ACCUSED TO STAND TRIAL WITH CONFIDENTIAL ANNEXES

On 28 April 2006, pursuant to Rules 54 and 126bis of the Rules, Trial Chamber III dismissed the motion by the Defence of Jovica Stanišić, filed on 28 February 2006, requesting the following:

- to stay the indictment and dismiss all the charges against the accused because the accused's medical condition makes a fair and expeditious trial not possible;
- in the alternative, to schedule the trial so as to provide the accused with the optimum conditions to prepare and understand the charges against him; and
- to hold an oral hearing into the accused's fitness to stand trial and scheduling of the trial to accommodate the accused's illness.
