# Vojislav ŠEŠELJ Case

Trial Chamber I – Judges Orie (Presiding), Robinson and Höpfel

On 1 November 2006, the parties met before the Trial Chamber for a Status Conference, during which the accused was removed from the courtroom because "he was engaging in disruptive conduct".

On the same day, the Trial Chamber ordered that another Status Conference be held on 3 November. The order stated, *inter alia*, that "as a consequence of the removal of the accused from the courtroom, the Trial Chamber did not have an opportunity to be informed by the accused, among other matters, about his preparedness to commence the trial."

During the Status Conference on 3 November, Judge Orie announced that the parties shall meet again on 8 November 2006 at 14:15 in courtroom II.
