## DECISION ON MOTION TO QUASH THE PRACTICE DIRECTION ON THE LENGTH OF BRIEFS AND MOTIONS

On 6 November 2006, the Bureau of the ICTY dismissed the accused's motion to quash the Practice Direction on the length of briefs and motions, filed on 4 October 2006.

## DECISION ON MOTIONS FOR DISQUALIFICATION OF JUDGE PATRICK ROBINSON, JUDGE ALPHONS ORIE AND JUDGE BAKONE JUSTICE MOLOTO

On 6 November 2006, the Bureau of the ICTY (Judges Pocar, Parker, Agius, Shahabuddeen and Güney) dismissed the motions of the accused requesting the disqualification and withdrawal of Judges Robinson, Orie and Moloto from the trial and appeal in this case.

#### DECISION ON THE APPLICATION OF RULE 73BIS

On 8 November, pursuant to Rule 73bis (D) of the Rules, Trial Chamber I ordered, inter alia, that counts 2,3,5,6 and 7 be removed from the indictment.

### DECISION ON DEFENCE'S SUBMISSION OF THE EXPERT REPORT OF PROFESSOR SMILJA AVRAMOV PURSUANT TO RULE 94BIS

On 9 November 2006, the Trial Chamber ordered, *inter alia*, that the expert report of Smilja Avramov be admitted in part and that the Defence shall bring her to appear before the Trial Chamber for cross-examination.

### DECISION ON DEFENCE MOTION FOR THE TESTIMONY OF PROFESSOR SMILJA AVRAMOV VIA VIDEO-CONFERENCE LINK

On 10 November 2006, pursuant to Rule 71*bis* of the Rules, Trial Chamber I ordered that the testimony of Smilja Avramov shall be received through video-conference link starting on 14 November 2006.
