SCHEDULING ORDER

On 15 March 2007, pursuant to Articles 20(1) and 21(4)(b) and (c) of the Statute and Rules 54, 65*ter*(G) and (M), 73*ter*, 84, 85(A)(ii), and 98*bis* of the Rules, the Trial Chamber ordered, *inter alia*, that:

- the Prosecution case shall end on 27 April 2007;
- oral judgement pursuant to Rule 98*bis*, if necessary, shall be delivered on 2 May 2007;
- the first witness for the Defence will be heard on 18 May 2007, following the Defence opening statement.
