## I. OVERVIEW OF COURT PROCEEDINGS

## MILUTINOVIĆ et al. Case

Trial Chamber III - Judges Bonomy (Presiding), Chowhan, Kamenova and Nosworthy (Reserve Judge)

#### Completion of the Prosecution case - Rule 98 bis submissions

On 1 May 2007, the Prosecution rested its case.

From 1 May until 4 May 2007, the parties presented oral submissions pursuant to Rule 98bis.
