#### **Completion of the Prosecution case - Rule 98bis judgement**

On 18 May 2007, the Trial Chamber rendered its Rule 98bis judgement and dismissed motions for acquittal for each of the accused.

The pre-defence Conference will be held on 22 June 2007.

## **II. OVERVIEW OF SELECTED COURT DOCUMENTS**

### **KRAJIŠNIK Case**

*Appeals Chamber - Judges Pocar (presiding), Shahabuddeen, Vaz, Meron and Schomburg*

#### **DECISION ON MOMČILO KRAJIŠNIK'S REQUEST TO SELF-REPRESENT, ON COUNSEL'S MOTIONS IN RELATION TO APPOINTMENT OF *AMICUS CURIAE*, AND ON THE PROSECUTION MOTION OF 16 FEBRUARY 2007**

On 11 May 2007, the Appeals Chamber ordered, *inter alia*, that Momčilo Krajišnik's request to represent himself be granted.

Furthermore, the Appeals Chamber granted the "Motion requesting assignment as *amicus curiae*", and the "Motion regarding proposed assignment as *amicus*" filed by the former assigned counsel Nicholls.

The Chamber also ordered Krajišnik to file his appeal brief within 75 days after the filing of the Trial Chamber judgement translated into B/C/S.

Judge Pocar and Judge Schomburg dissented from this decision whereas Judge Shahabuddeen filed a separate opinion.

### **PRLIĆ et al. Case**

*Appeals Chamber - Judges Pocar (presiding), Shahabuddeen, Güney, Vaz and Schomburg*

#### **DECISION ON PROSECUTION APPEAL FOLLOWING TRIAL CHAMBER'S DECISION ON REMAND AND FURTHER CERTIFICATION**

On 11 May 2007, the Appeals Chamber dismissed the Prosecution appeal against the Trial Chamber decision reducing the allocated time for the presentation of the Prosecution case by 107 hours.

#### **DECISION ON APPLICATION OF RULE 73*bis* AND AMENDMENT OF INDICTMENT**

On 15 May 2007, the Trial Chamber ordered, *inter alia*, that the Prosecution will file an amended indictment containing all the proposed amendments.

The order stated that "in order to reduce the amended indictment pursuant to Rule 73*bis*, the Prosecution shall not lead evidence on terror in relation to the Sarajevo counts."

### **ŠEŠELJ Case**

*Trial Chamber III - Judges Robinson (presiding), Antonetti and Bonomy*

#### **ORDER REGARDING MR. ŠEŠELJ'S MOTION FOR CONTEMPT PROCEEDINGS**

On 15 May 2007, pursuant to Rule 54 of the Rules, the Trial Chamber ordered the postponement of a determination of the request for the initiation and execution of contempt proceedings against Carla Del

Ponte, Hildegard Uertz-Retzlaff and Daniel Saxon, filed by the accused on 23 March 2007, until after the completion of the trial.
