DECISION ON DEFENDANT ANTE GOTOVINA'S EMERGENCY MOTION TO LIFT CONFIDENTIALITY OF PROSECUTION'S CLARIFICATION OF INDICTMENT FILED 17 MAY 2007

On 31 May 2007, pursuant to Articles 20 and 21 of the Statute and Rules 53 and 54 of the Rules, the Trial Chamber granted a Defence motion and lifted the confidential status of the Prosecution's "Clarification of indictment", which was subsequently filed publicly on the same day.

ORDER TO THE PROSECUTOR UNDER RULE 77

On 1 June 2007, pursuant to Rules 54 and 77 of the Rules, the Trial Chamber directed the Prosecution to investigate the matter of possible contempt of court after the Chamber was informed that the contents of the "Clarification of indictment" had been broadcast by the Croatian television before the lifting of confidentiality.
